



Littledown Harriers Awards Nominations Procedure and Guidance

Harrier of the Quarter - HOTQ

- Awarded three times per year for the three months up to and including September, December, March, and replaced with Harrier of the Year award instead for that quarter at the AGM in June.
 - Any current member can nominate another member for HOTQ.
 - One male and one female nomination per member.
 - Reasons for nominations should be given.
 - The award can only be won by any one individual once per year (running from AGM to AGM).
 - Nominations can be made in recognition of a range of achievements, such as but not limited to the following;
 - Work done for the club - coaching/support assistance to others
 - Runners coming back from injury, overcoming adversity
 - Improved running times
 - Club attendance
 - Specific incident or achievement

 - Once the nominations period has closed, a list of all nominees will be collated along with reasons, and this will be shared with all members.
 - Members will then be eligible to vote for one male and one female winner.
 - Members who nominated someone will still need to vote for their chosen winner - nominations do not carry forward as votes. You do not have to vote for the person/people you nominate.
 - The male and female with the most votes, who have not been awarded HOTQ within the last year (since the AGM) will then be awarded with HOTQ.
 - In the event of a tie, both will be presented with the award.
 - The award will be presented at a suitable location such as before Tuesday club runs or at the Presentation Evening. This will be advertised in advance.
 - Winners will be shared on social media and email, and included on the club website.
 - A photograph at the presentation will be obtained, with the winner's permission, and this will be shared along with news of the winner.

Harrier of the Year - HOTY

- Any current member can nominate another member for HOTY.
- One male and one female nomination per member.
- Nominations can be made in recognition of a range of achievements, such as but not limited to the following;
 - Attendance over the year at club sessions or at races
 - Continued improvement over the year
 - Return from injury, overcoming adversity
 - Assistance or support for others
 - Any incident or event where someone feels another runner deserves recognition
- HOTQ winners since the previous AGM will also be included on the ballot to be awarded HOTY.
- Once nominations for HOTY have closed, all nominations will be collated and shared with members to be voted on prior to the AGM.
- Each member has one male and one female vote.
- Members who nominated someone will still need to vote for their chosen winner - nominations do not carry forward as votes. You do not have to vote for the person/people you nominate.
- The members with the most votes will win the award. In the event of a tie, both will be presented with the award.
- Winners will be shared on social media and email, and included on the club website.
- A photograph at the presentation will be obtained, with the winner's permission, and this will be shared along with news of the winner.

There are no restrictions to the frequency with which an individual can win this award.

Bush Forman Trophy

- Committee and coaches vote for the person who they feel has done the most for the club over the last 12 months. The person with the most votes will win.
- In the case of a tie, the Chair will have the deciding vote.
- The award is presented at the AGM.
